Open call for European volunteers

Hosting organization

We are an umbrella organization of 38 institutions, associations and groups in the field of child and youth work in Esslingen. We see ourselves as a contact point to support and secure the conceptual and educational work in the field of children and young people in the city. We are also a service point for matters relating to child and youth work, advise and support associations.



Our main tasks are improving the living conditions of children and young people, representing the interests of children, teenagers and young adults in political matters, supporting the professional development of the youth work in Esslingen and providing advice and support for associations, groups and volunteers.

We offer a varied range of activities for young people between 6 and 27 years of age in Esslingen, that appeal to different abilities and interests and convey joy and fun.

We provide children and young people with various opportunities to support their development.

We support self-determined activities by children and young people and offer them the opportunity to try out and implement their own ideas and projects.

The children and young people are motivated to actively help shape their social and living environment.

We promote the development and stabilization of democratic action by offering a wide range of participation opportunities and motivating children and young people to have a word in the organization.

We arrange our offers in such a way that they are available to all children and young people in Esslingen.

The main projects

The volunteer, apart from supporting the office, will be active in two main projects:



The project “**Spielmobil**” offers an open space for children in elementary school age. It is taking place inside schools with direct cooperation of the institutions, but also in schoolyards, in parks, on playgrounds, in narrow residential areas or in the middle of the street. The goal of the project is to promote free activities and free play, offering several creative

occasions to build connections in a solidarity environment, giving open space to youth work and ideas, offering the space and the tools to the children to express themselves while being in a group context, exercising the mutual respect, integration and building simple group roles and rules, regardless of age, origin, education, physical impairment or language.

The project “**Jugendtreff Zell**” offers an open space for youngsters from 11 years of age, to meet and spend their time. This project offers a lot of material, such as table football, tables, benches, mattresses, footballs, table tennis bats, slackline, loud speaker, laptop, beamer and much more. Like Spielmobil it is not limited to a single location: with its mobile tent it moves around the district Esslingen-Zell. The youngsters can decide to hang out as well to plan and organize special projects.



Tasks and housing

The ESC volunteer will support the two mentioned projects. That includes the promotion within the local community of children and youngsters, taking care of material, of organizing and planning of the activities. The volunteer will have the possibility to take part in all the phases of the activities, directly interact with the participants, and propose ideas of his/her own to enrich the project with intercultural exchange. The volunteer will actively contribute to an environment where the mutual respect, the cohesion and the concepts of sharing and caring are essential to build a healthy and solid community climate. Besides that, the volunteer will support the team in the office, organizing internal data, appointments, events.

The volunteer will have 24 days of vacation and be paid a pocket money and food allowance for a total of 525 Euro per month.

The volunteer will be accommodated in the flat community of Stadtjugendring with a room for him-/herself. It is located in the same building as the office. The flat mates share the kitchen, bathroom and a common room.

The volunteer gets a card for the public transport, so he/she can travel with the tram, train and bus for free.



Coordinating organization

The Kreisjugendwerk (KJW) of the AWO Karlsruhe-Stadt is the non-profit children and youth's department of the AWO (Arbeiterwohlfahrt). The KJW is the coordinating organization, that means it will provide the structural framework for the voluntary service and provide assistance for the entire duration of the voluntary service.

As an independent organisation, the KJW organizes leisure activities for children and young people between the ages of 6 and 20, extracurricular education and workshops, as well as intercultural encounters and projects for young people and young adults between 15 and 27. Our work focuses on participation and personal development, and our activities are also deliberately offered to children and young people from socially disadvantaged backgrounds and to young people with a migration background. Besides coordinating the voluntary service, we are organising a lot of camps and holidays for young people in Germany and abroad.
